Day One

From there, tour **Monuments** on the National Mall, including the **National World War II Memorial**, **Vietnam Veterans Memorial**, **Lincoln Memorial**, and **Korean War Veterans Memorial**. This afternoon see the Declaration of Independence, Constitution and other national treasures in the **National Archives**. Dinner this evening is at a **student-friendly restaurant**. Cap off the evening with a walk through the **Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts** where you'll enjoy the spectacular view from the rooftop terrace.

Enjoy **lunch** today at the Zoo. This afternoon depart and drive along Embassy Row en route to tour **Ford's Theatre**. Later in the afternoon, stroll along the Tidal Basin and see the **NEW Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. National Memorial**, **Franklin D. Roosevelt Memorial**, and **Jefferson Memorial**. Dinner this evening is at a **food court** before a **Twilight Tour** of the **Pentagon 9/11 Memorial Park** and **Air Force Memorial**.

Day Two

Start off this morning after breakfast with a walking tour of **Arlington National Cemetery**, including the opportunity to witness the Changing of the Guard. We'll stop at the **Marine**

Our last morning starts with breakfast before visiting the **White House** for a photo opportunity. Enjoy **lunch** today at the **Smithsonian Institution's National Air & Space & Museum**, and spend the rest of your trip exploring all of the museums on the **National Mall** at your leisure!
